With ease of pandemic in this period, Vidyadhaara Foundation has continued its initiatives blending online and offline modes. With the support of patrons and volunteers, our programs have reached many needy beneficiaries.

Academic activities at our Study centre:

- 1. Offline sessions of Science tuition with experiments have been taking place for about 7 students of 7th and 8th grades, along with other subjects.
- 2. We have been conducting Maths and Science sessions for 9th graders in the offline mode with teaching support by volunteers Mr. Andy and Mr. Sumit.
- 3. We arranged a spoken English course to students who are looking to develop their confidence and improve their employability. About 15 students completed the course.

Academic activities as Govt. Primary School:

- 1. VF has been conducting Basic English course for children at Govt. Primary school Doddanekkundi for a few years now. This year we have engaged a few enthusiastic young girls who are alumins of the same school, to teach English to kids of Grade 1 to 3 under the guidance of VF Volunteers. We trust this experience will give them an oppurtunity to explore teaching as a career.
- 2. With help of volunteers we have assisted students of 6th and 7th to prepare a science project proposal.
- 3. We have provided a supply of sanitisers.
